HEBREWS: LIVING IN THE NEW COVENANT REALITY

PART 1

If Hebrews isn't one of your favorite books of the Bible, then you might be missing a key aspect of grace. The same goes for Romans and Galatians. These three books are fundamental to grasping the essence of the New Covenant.

Hebrews was originally written for Jewish believers who had a tendency of trying to blend Old Testament performance-based laws with the freedom in Christ the New Covenant offers. Sad to say, the vast majority of Christians today fall into the same trap. They might profess that they're living under New Covenant grace, but in reality, they're mixing in Old Testament legalism. The truth is, these two covenants cannot be mixed. The Old Testament is awesome in so many ways and points us to Jesus, but it was incomplete.

But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises. For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second.

Hebrews 8:6–7

I spend a lot of time reading the Old Testament, and I'm not suggesting we get rid of it. But I'm living under the New Covenant, and I am not under the curse and the punishment of the Old Testament Law.

There is a huge difference between the Old Covenant and the New Covenant, yet the average Christian fails to understand the difference and misses out on living in the victory and freedom that Jesus purchased for us. The old system of animal sacrifice was only a temporary, imperfect way to deal with sin. Out of love, God the Father sent His only Son, Jesus, into the world and established a new covenant that would resolve the problem of sin once and for all.

THE DEITY OF JESUS

Another major point that's emphasized in Hebrews is the deity of Jesus. To me, the real dividing line between a cult and true Christianity hinges on the deity of Jesus. Jesus isn't just a good teacher or a prophet; He is God incarnate (1 Tim. 3:16). He is the exact representation of God's glory (Heb. 1:3).

This isn't theological debate—it's a foundational truth that separates true Christianity from every other belief system. Cults like Jehovah's Witnesses acknowledge Jesus as a great man, but they deny His deity. Others like Mormonism have created a completely unbiblical definition of God that nullifies any profession they make about Jesus being God. But Scripture is clear: Jesus is God.

The first chapter of Hebrews opens with a powerful declaration. It establishes not only the deity of Jesus but also His superiority over any other way that God ever spoke to people:

God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds.

Hebrews 1:1–2

What an awesome statement! You know, in Luke 2:11 when the angels declared that Jesus was "Christ the Lord," it wasn't just a title; it was a proclamation of His deity. Yet in His human form, Jesus grew in wisdom and stature (Luke 2:52), experiencing life like us but without sin. His earthly body concealed His divine glory, but it was revealed momentarily on the Mount of Transfiguration (Matt. 17:1–6).

Understanding Jesus' deity is absolutely critical to salvation and faith, and it underscores the power of the New Covenant. Jesus came as God in the flesh and sacrificed Himself once and for all. And His payment for the sins of all humanity is totally and completely sufficient (Heb. 9–10). No more yearly reminders of sin; Jesus paid it all. Man, that's awesome!

I hope you are beginning to get a better grasp of God's grace. I'm talking about the profound, life-changing grace that empowers you to experience freedom and God's presence now. Maybe you're reading this and feeling stuck in your walk with the Lord. You've accepted Christ and you know you're saved, but victory in your daily life seems out of reach. If you think that joy, prosperity,

and peace are things reserved for heaven, let me challenge you with Galatians 1:4:

Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father.

The point I'm making is that Jesus came to deliver us from this present evil world—right here, right now. Consider how He taught us to pray in Matthew 6:10: *"Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven."* That's not just a future hope; it's a present reality! Healing, prosperity, joy, peace—they're all part of the package Jesus secured for us. Yet too many Christians struggle to grasp this because they're mixing Old Covenant Law with New Covenant grace. And that's like trying to put new wine into old wineskins, just as Jesus warned:

Neither do men put new wine into old bottles: else the bottles break, and the wine runneth out, and the bottles perish: but they put new wine into new bottles, and both are preserved.

Matthew 9:17

This is talking about how you can't mix the Old Covenant with the New Covenant. Trying to relate to God based on the Old Covenant just won't work. You're either justified by grace without works or by works without grace. It's one or the other, not a hybrid version.

And if by grace, then is it no more of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. But if it be of works, then is it no more grace: otherwise work is no more work.

Romans 11:6

If you wrestle with doubts or feel trapped in a cycle of religious performance, I want you to know the God who loves you and offers you freedom and victory today, not just in eternity.





ANDREW'S ANECDOTES

COUNTERACTING CULTURE AND NEGATIVE NEWS WITH ANDREW

QUESTION: Is God in control of everything?

Andrew's Answer: This is the most common faith killer that I run into. People who've been taught that God just sovereignly controls things believe it's up to God whether you get healed or whether anything happens. If you believe that, you're going to believe God causes good things to happen, but you'll also blame God for bad things like rape, murder, plunder, and everything else. That is totally wrong!

Think of it this way: Does God control everything that you do? Has there ever been an instance where God told you to do something, and you went the other direction? I think you'd have to say yes. And if He doesn't control you like a robot, what makes you think He controls everybody else like a robot?

The Believer's Authority is one of my teachings, and it goes into a lot of explanation about this. God wants us to follow Him and resist attacks of the enemy.

*Submit yourselves therefore to God.
Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.*

James 4:7

This verse reveals that God wants good things for you and the devil wants bad things for you. If you really believe pain and sickness are from God, why would you resist them and go to the doctor or take medicine to get out of the will of God? The enemy wants to keep you confused about this, but the truth is, God is good, and He only wants good things for you.

QUESTION: Is God bigger than Parkinson's disease?

Andrew's Answer: Yes! I've seen a number of people healed from Parkinson's disease. One time I saw it happen in Buena Vista at a Ministers Conference. If you're reading this and you have Parkinson's disease, we command it to leave, and we believe that your body is recovering in Jesus' name. Amen.



REIGNING IN HUMILITY THROUGH CHRIST

Humility brings us to a place where we recognize what's of real value and move forward into the future God wants for us. However, it also requires us to make a decision about the past. Does your past define you? Or are you allowing the Word of God to define you in Christ?

Pride exalts your past and uses it to define you, limit you, or disqualify you in some way. We all have regrets and a past that we look back on and wish we'd handled differently. But many of us allow regret, shame, guilt, damage, or consequences to draw a line in the sand, restricting where we can go, what we can do, or who we can become.

That's the strategy of the enemy, who lost you at salvation. Now he tries to keep you tangled up in the past and things of this world to stop you from walking in the fullness of your salvation.

Satan is constantly trying to hinder you with your biggest hindrance—you!

Once we realize our biggest hindrance is ourselves, we can come to a place of understanding that our way, our plans, and our desires are nothing compared to the life God has for us. We can learn to give everything to God and die to ourselves so that Christ can live through us (Gal. 2:20).

Yes, you've had some successes and some failures, but now those things belong to Christ. Now you can move into the future God has for you with nothing holding you back. The Apostle Paul wrote:

But what things were gain to me, those I counted loss for Christ. Yea doubtless, and I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ.

Philippians 3:7-8

Paul's values completely shifted from caring about himself and his accomplishments to caring only about Jesus. He basically said, "Look, I don't care if I lose all things, because I found the only thing that matters: Jesus Christ."

If you can get past your past—whether good or bad—and embrace humility, accepting what the Word says about you as truth, then you can press forward and forget those things that are behind (Phil. 3:12-13). Forgetting them means that the past is no longer a voice that dictates what you can and cannot do. Amen.

what. She understood that God's Word already provided healing for her body by the stripes of Jesus (1 Pet. 2:24), and she received it by faith. Soon after, she conceived her second baby, defying the limitations set by medical science.

However, the battle wasn't over. As her pregnancy progressed, she began to bleed, a common symptom of a miscarriage. Once again, Marie stood in her newfound authority in Christ and commanded the bleeding to stop. She knew it had to obey.

Her second son, August, was born healthy, a living testament to faith and the power of God's Word. Marie's story is an encouraging reminder to keep expecting, keep believing, and to never lose hope. With God, all things are possible (Matt. 19:26), and our faith can move the very mountains that stand in our way.


It is often in our darkest moments that God's strength shines through our weaknesses to help us receive what we need. Marie's story is a testament to the power of unwavering belief and the impact it can have on our lives.

During her first year of Charis online courses, Marie discovered that her son, Melker, had developed scaphocephaly, a skull deformity that could lead to serious health complications. Refusing to accept the dire prognosis, Marie instead retreated to a quiet cabin and immersed herself in truth, listening to Andrew's teachings, reading the Word, and praying in tongues. After praying in tongues one day, God revealed to her what she should do.

Following God's prompting, Marie placed her hand on Melker's head. She prayed in tongues and asked the Lord for the interpretation of what she was praying. He told her that Melker would be healed. Instantly, she felt the bones of his skull shift and realign, a tangible manifestation of God's healing power. The results of a subsequent medical scan confirmed the miracle—Melker's head was perfect!

This experience emboldened Marie to face another mountain: her own infertility. Having conceived Melker through in vitro fertilization, Marie was told that further treatments were unlikely to be successful. However, she refused to let medical reports define her future. She delved into the Scriptures to find a promise to stand on for her healing.

While outside one day, Marie drew a line in the sand and stepped over it, symbolizing her resolve to believe God's Word and trust Him no matter



RESTING IN RHYTHMS OF GRACE

It's easy to feel overwhelmed by the demands and pressures of everyday life in a fallen world. If you find yourself yearning for a rest that renews and strengthens you, you're not alone. I firmly believe that Jesus offers us this rest—a rest that goes beyond mere physical relaxation.

Early in my ministry, I struggled with the pressure to be perfect. I thought loving Jesus meant doing and saying everything right. This burden was heavy until I learned an important truth: Jesus is our Sabbath rest. As Christians, we need to understand how to rest in Jesus. He said,

Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.

Matthew 11:28–30


How can we do this in a practical sense? It involves maintaining a close, personal relationship with Jesus through a regular routine of natural, unforced activities like prayer and studying the Word. By making these practices a part of our daily lives, we develop spiritual muscle memory that will sustain us during times of crisis.

Building spiritual strength this way is similar to how athletes build muscle memory through practice. Just as daily tennis practice makes certain movements second nature, daily time with Jesus, taking His yoke, and learning from Him helps us develop mindsets that become a natural rhythm. And when our lives flow from this rhythm, it creates a supernatural rest that helps us operate in God's strength and wisdom more easily.

I remember being overwhelmed by the expectation of needing to have all the answers. But God gave me peace and taught me that it's okay not to have all the answers. When faced with sudden trials and tragedies that inevitably happen in this broken world, we can trust God because of what we know about His love and faithfulness. Romans 8:28 reassures us, *"And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose"* (New King James Version).

During my ministry, I've faced many trials and struggles, but the regular rhythms of grace in my life have helped me overcome and grow through them while witnessing firsthand how Jesus sustained me. When you apply rhythms of grace into your daily activities, you can experience peace, joy, and effectiveness as you fulfill God's purposes for your life.

GOD LIKES FAITH: LEARNING TO LIVE BY IT!

Left to themselves, people often lack faith and tend to give up when the challenges of the world weigh them down. But in God’s kingdom, you don’t get what you deserve or earn—you get what you believe for.

God likes faith. Think about how many times Jesus talked to people about their faith, highlighting how their faith made them well and when a lack of faith was a problem. Hebrews says,

But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Hebrews 11:6, emphasis added

It takes faith to believe in God and to believe His Word. He’s invisible, and we can’t see or touch Him. When we pray, it must be in faith. We get born again through faith. And when we believe for His blessings and promises, we have to believe by faith.

All it takes is a promise and someone who believes. God has put promises in His Word, and we can mix faith with His promises and receive all that He has for us. Did you know that your life can be a supernatural event that showcases the promises of God as you run your race?

Faith should be a way of life. It’s not just a bunch of principles or a magic formula that we use to get things out of God. Colossians 2:6 says, *“As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him.”*

If you’re a child of God, God has a plan for you. He has a covenant with you. He’s made promises to you that are not dependent on outside circumstances. At Jesus’ word, Peter believed to walk on the water during a storm. He got out of the boat in faith and obeyed the word of Jesus by faith, and that’s what kept him above the water.

At one point, though, Peter began to doubt. If you were trying to walk on water, you might think the same thing, right? You can’t walk on water! But you can if Jesus tells you to do it. God’s plan

and guidance for your life might seem impossible, but His promises never fail, and they will get you across the finish line.


So, what has God been prompting you to do? This is the time to get your eyes off the wind and the waves, keep your eyes on Jesus, and start walking by faith and not by sight. Faith is the victory (1 John 5:4)!

I hope you are beginning to get a better grasp of God’s grace. I’m talking about the profound, life-changing grace that empowers you to experience freedom and God’s presence now. Maybe you’re reading this and feeling stuck in your walk with the Lord. You’ve accepted Christ and you know you’re saved, but victory in your daily life seems out of reach. If you think that joy, prosperity, and peace are things reserved for heaven, let me challenge you with Galatians 1:4:

Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father.

The point I’m making is that Jesus came to deliver us from this present evil world—right here, right now. Consider how He taught us to pray in Matthew 6:10: “Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.” That’s not just a future hope; it’s a present reality! Healing, prosperity, joy, peace—they’re all part of the package Jesus secured for us. Yet too many Christians struggle to grasp this because they’re mixing Old Covenant Law with New Covenant grace. And that’s like trying to put new wine into old wineskins, just as Jesus warned:

Neither do men put new wine into old bottles: else the bottles break, and the wine runneth out, and the bottles perish: but they put new wine into new bottles, and both are preserved.

Matthew 9:17

This is talking about how you can’t mix the Old Covenant with the New Covenant. Trying to relate to God based on the Old Covenant just won’t work. You’re either justified by grace without works or by works without grace. It’s one or the other, not a hybrid version.

And if by grace, then is it no more of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. But if it be of works, then is it no more grace: otherwise work is no more work.

Romans 11:6

If you wrestle with doubts or feel trapped in a cycle of religious performance, I want you to know the God who loves you and offers you freedom and victory today, not just in eternity.

I encourage you to get my full teaching **Hebrews: Living in the New Covenant Reality**. I believe it will transform your understanding of what Jesus has accomplished for you.



