WHERE IN THE WORLD IS

In the northeast region of Uganda lies Karamoja—an area approximately 17,500 square miles in size, home to nearly 1.2 million people, that forms a substantial part of Uganda's eastern border with Kenya. Extinct volcanic mountains averaging 10,000 feet in height dot this part of the Uganda-Kenya border, with Mount Elgon towering majestically at over 14,000 feet.

Reaching the Far Corners of the World

The northern edge of Karamoja borders southern Sudan, home of one of Africa's longest-running civil wars, which has raged intermittently since 1955 in three separate campaigns, claiming 2.5 million lives. Situated between Sudan and Uganda, the remote and arid region of Karamoja appears to have been passed over and barely touched by modern times, as the nomadic Karamojong warriors have survived by living and wandering with their cattle for centuries.

The term *Karamojong* applies specifically to the main tribes of the Bokora, Pian, and Matheniko, even though Karamoja is comprised of seven different districts and fourteen tribes—each with their own language. In recent years, the Karamojong's nomadic lifestyle has come under increasing pressure as their pasture lands and culture are being compromised on several fronts, including political and commercial tensions, changing demographics, and continuing unrest.

This increased pressure has led to a two-tiered society: those who have chosen to settle in the growing towns of Karamoja—such as the Amudat, Moroto, Kotido, and Kaabong—and the traditional tribesmen who seek to maintain a lifestyle where cattle are the main currency. Over time, the continued conflicts over cattle and rangelands between Kenyan and Karamojong tribes have turned brutal with the wholesale slaughter of entire villages.

During Idi Amin's reign (1971-1979), he attempted to wipe out the Karamojong by slaughtering them and their cattle. Similarly, from 2007-2011, government troops have been used to carry out a forced disarmament of Karamojong tribesmen. It is estimated that only 5 to 10 percent of the available weapons have actually been recovered during this United Nationssponsored initiative. This left the Karamojong more vulnerable to attack from their neighbors, and Karamoja itself is still a potentially dangerous place.



Why AWM Got Involved

Before Jesus left earth, He commanded His followers to go and make disciples of all nations (Matt. 28:19-20 [New King James Version], see also Mark 16:15-20). Andrew has taken this command to heart and desires to reach as far and deep as possible with the nearly-too-good-to-be-true news. No geographical area or people group is excluded from Jesus' command.

Several years ago, the late Charis Bible College Uganda director Leland Shores, along with other faithful men and women, laid a foundation by preaching the Gospel in Uganda and introducing Andrew's teachings. Lighthouse Television in Kampala has aided these efforts by broadcasting the Gospel and Andrew's messages twice daily since 2005.

To carry out the discipleship mission in Karamoja, an Andrew Wommack Ministries (AWM) team of Ugandan pastors are showing the *Jesus* film (dubbed into the Karamojong language) throughout Karamojan villages. Following this is a presentation of the Gospel message and an invitation for salvation. Those who receive salvation are discipled at church centers in six of the seven districts in Karamoja via the *Discipleship Evangelism* course. These new disciples then take the Gospel even deeper into the bush to disciple others.

Currently hundreds of people are being discipled in Karamoja—primarily in the larger towns but it's steadily moving out to reach the more traditional tribes. The challenges are much greater there due to the culture and lack of basic resources such as water, food, education, and security.

Two years ago, Andrew visited a church in Moroto and a traditional village where he was touched by the plight of the Karamojong people, who are the poorest of the poor in one of the world's most impoverished countries. He determined then that he wanted to do something to help the people who have been discipled in these areas.

His goal was to employ a simple strategy of "giving them the Word and teaching them to fish." In January of 2014, Mark Rowe, AWM's director of international operations, was charged with the task of evaluating the effectiveness of the discipleship training in Karamoja and finding out how the AWM team could help these wonderful people.

As AWM continues to penetrate the Karamojong, long-term goals are to make disciples and to teach those disciples self-sufficiency to pull themselves out of poverty.

Next Steps

The Karamoja challenge is enormous, as this area is arid, inhospitable, hard to reach, and void of sufficient water—even in the larger towns. Existing water is often undrinkable and accounts for half of all deaths. Karamojong women spend all day in the hot bush without water, collecting bundles of sticks, which they carry on their heads. The women are faced with the tough choice of using those sticks as firewood to boil and sanitize their water or selling them to make money to buy food.

The following are urgent needs for the Karamoja Project:

• Install Community Water Filters — There is a network of seventy-nine churches of the PAGU (Pentecostal Assemblies of God of Uganda) that AWM partners with in Karamoja. AWM's goal is to work with a British charity in Uganda that designs and

manufactures water filters locally, and to install a community water filter in each of the churches. The cost will be \$10,000 in total, but once installed, these filters will provide clean water for a community of up to 200 people for an entire year, without the need for electricity or boiling.

- Develop a Microfinance Loan Program A Charis graduate from the United States would be trained in Kampala by a partner organization established in microfinance (small business) loans. Located in Kampala and working with the Karamoja team, the graduate would initiate a loan-outreach program in one of the larger towns in Karamoja. These microfinance loans will ultimately create employment and raise the living standards of disciples in Karamoja. The graduate would also be responsible for working with Charis Uganda to train other Ugandan students in microfinance. The total cost for all of this will be about \$35,000 a year.
- Build Community Development Pilot
 Programs We would begin one or two
 major community development projects.

 These would be based at strategically

identified church locations, which are also discipling centers, to serve as pilot programs. This would entail the drilling of a reliable, powered water well to irrigate land surrounding the church locations, enabling crop planting and the raising of livestock. The water would eventually be piped to surrounding villages and other establishments, such as government schools where no water supplies exist. Churches would become the focal point of these communities, and education and microfinance could be introduced as each project and community becomes established and begins to prosper. The pilot programs would enable AWM to develop working models that can be replicated elsewhere throughout the region as well as in other African countries. Karamoja is just the beginning! This is the largest project of all and will involve drilling a major well in each of the two locations. Then, for one location, we'll provide seeds, crops, poultry, and livestock, while in the other, we'll be applying "Aquaponics," drip irrigation, and building greenhouses. The estimated cost for the work in both locations is \$100,000.



• Discipleship through a Team of Pastors — We have the ongoing cost of \$4,000 every month for Karamoja pastors who go into the bush making converts through the Jesus movie, which is dubbed into the Karamojong languages. They then disciple these people, as well as others they are already discipling, in eighty locations all over Karamoja. This includes the printing of the teaching materials in both English and Karamojong. The total annual cost is \$48,000.

The total, over the next twelve months, is a little over \$200,000. By God's grace and His promised provision (Phil. 4:19), the AWM Karamoja team will make a difference. We may not change the *entire* world immediately, but we can begin by changing *someone's* world.

This month, Andrew is making another trip to Karamoja and will personally present the pastors and leaders with six motorbikes to share. They'll be able to safely travel great distances, to outlying churches and communities, which they previously had to cover by foot. The Gospel will continue to reach far and deep. Praise God for His provision!

on the Road with Andrew FROM GLORY TO GLORY

NEW BEGINNINGS

Last May, Andrew once again crossed the Atlantic—on a mission to see more lives changed. He hosted the annual four-day *Grace & Faith Conference* at the International Centre in Telford. In spite of the expense—it costs about £140,000—Andrew was led to make registration *free*. The attendance leapt to 3,300 (a 50 percent increase), and for the first time in the history of those meetings, the ministry came out in the black. Andrew's response? "See what happens when you give? Trust God!"

Charlie and Jill LeBlanc, along with Charis Bible College instructor Pastor Duane Sheriff, shared the platform with Andrew, and Deborah McDermott recounted the tremendous healing of her autistic sons. On the very first night, when Andrew gave an invitation for the baptism of the Holy Spirit, a man came forward pulling an oxygen tank. He was so weak, he passed out. The people behind him picked him up, and a large gentleman stood at his back with his arms locked across the man's chest. Andrew spoke to him strongly: "In the name of Jesus, I believe you're healed!" The next morning, the man was running around and climbing stairs—without tubes in his nose. He was completely healed and had enjoyed the best night sleep he'd had in years. Many other miracles occurred during the conference.

In the Netherlands, Andrew faced the religion of Calvinism. He considers himself "just about the



antithesis of Calvinism," so when it was time to preach, he was excited to share the Truth with almost 1,000 people. He was later surprised when a couple approached him he had met three years prior in the States. It was after someone had shared with the wife Andrew's book *God Wants You Well* because of an ear problem she was having. When she came to his meetings in the Netherlands, she was still suffering from a buzzing pressure in her head. When prayed, she was healed on the spot.

The couple also had a sick child, who wouldn't let anyone touch him and wouldn't look anyone in the face. Andrew recounts the situation: "He was really fidgety, so I just prayed with him. He stared at me, and I said, 'You're healed!' Then he threw his arms up, making fists in the air, and shouted, 'YES!' Afterward, he gave me a big hug." The little boy was transformed, and though the family is still walking out his full healing, there was an instant manifestation. Andrew connected the mother with Deborah McDermott, who would continue to minister encouragement and the healing Word.

In Germany, Andrew held meetings at a church in Weisbaden. Nearly 1,500 attended—it was so packed that people were sitting on the stairs to the balcony!

The Charis Birkenfeld graduating class and twenty-five of their correspondence students were also there. The pastor, Andreas, even in financial straits, donated the use of the church and asked Andrew to keep the offering. But Andrew told the people, "Do you realize how rare this is? I'm going to take up an offering and give it all back to the church. I want this to be the biggest offering they've ever received." Along with Andrew Wommack Ministries' gift, they received tens of thousands of Euros. Sure enough, it was the largest offering they had ever received. God is good!

In Nice, France, the meetings were attended by about 130 people, which, to Pastor Marie-Hélène, was a large crowd. She and her sister, Elizabeth, had an average of 40 or 50 people in their church. Of the spiritual climate in France, Andrew says, "It's a hard, hard, hard place." The government refuses to let the church occupy a building, advertise in the paper, or hold "religious" meetings. It's against the law to lay hands on the young or old, and a pastor can take no salary. Marie-Hélène has to be totally supported from outside her church. To generate outreach, Andrew plans to go on the radio there.

Because it was a smaller crowd, Andrew was able to spend a lot of time with the people, and as he ministered, pain left them. He told others in the group they needed to practice what he just preached—to lay hands on people and release the power of God that was in them. The congregation, normally very reserved, began to reach out. People were born again and received the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

Shortly after the meeting in France, Andrew boarded a plane back to the States. He has traveled to Europe more than 100 times now. This most recent trip, combined with his meeting in the States, has stirred his heart about stepping into this new role—that of prophet—in order to bring the freedom of the Gospel to more people than ever before. Praise be to God! GT

The Power of Partnership

WHAT DOES PARTNERSHIP ACCOMPLISH?

Who says you can't prosper during these current economic times? Did you know that Isaac went through a tougher time than you've probably experienced. He was a stranger in a land plagued with drought and famine. Yet when most were afraid to work their fields, Isaac took a seemingly foolish risk and sowed in the land.

Then Isaac sowed in that land, and received in the same year an hundredfold: and the LORD blessed him.

Genesis 26:12

How could Isaac have the peace necessary to sow seed during a drought? Simply put, Isaac trusted God. You need to trust Him as well. Look how it worked out for Isaac! It's nothing short of a miracle that he received a hundredfold in a time of famine.

As irrational as it appeared for Isaac to sow seed in a land of lack, it is just as irrational to cut back on our own sowing when we are experiencing need. We reap what we sow (Gal. 6:7). When we find ourselves in a financial drought, it is the perfect opportunity to believe God like never before. We can demonstrate to the world, as Isaac did, that there is a God in heaven who blesses His people even in the worst times.

But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:19

Benjamin Hutcherson, a college student, began listening to Andrew's teachings about finances, and it

changed the way he thought about money: "What really impacted me from Andrew's *Financial Stewardship* teaching was when he taught from the parable of the unjust steward in Luke 16. I realized that the primary and highest use of my finances was not for my physical necessities but, rather, to make an eternal difference in the lives of other people by sowing into the kingdom of God."

While he was attending a local community college, Benjamin paid for school out-of-pocket. Although he wasn't making a lot of money, he was able to tithe as well as cover his college costs. Benjamin knew, however, that in order to earn a four-year degree, he would have to transfer to a full-time college or university and his expenses would be significantly higher. As he considered what to do, he continued to listen to Andrew's teachings.

Having seen so many college students amass mountains of debt, Benjamin decided he did not want to borrow any money. He would pass on any sort of financial assistance, even from his parents. Instead, he would choose to trust God for his provision. "All of those specific teachings were foundational in my decision to go to college debt free," he explains. "I continued to meditate on those principles. I just considered financial debt as bondage and a curse, as Deuteronomy 28 describes. I believed that the borrower is servant to the lender, as it says in Proverbs 22:7. I didn't want that for me or my family."

Once Benjamin determined he would attend college debt free, he settled on Columbia College in Chicago because of his passion for art, specifically drawing and animation. His tuition costs significantly increased, from \$1,600 per year to \$10,000 per semester, plus books, materials, and a \$150-per-month Metra train ticket. "I did not have a clue as to how I was going to pay for Columbia. So, I registered without knowing how I was going to receive the money. I resolved that either God would pay for it or I would just drop out, simple as that," he recalls frankly.

Benjamin meditated on the Word and took comfort in the Scriptures about Abraham and how he simply believed God. "I told myself, 'I don't care what my bank account says, what my college advisors say, what my parents say, or what anybody else has to say. I'm going to trust God; and He's going to provide for me."

Benjamin says Andrew's teaching inspired him to give freely. Although Benjamin always tithed, he had never sown into special projects. "What liberated me to give so radically was this: Since I could never afford to pay for college, even if I saved all my money, I decided I would just give as much as I pleased." Sometimes giving away half his paycheck, Benjamin gave extra to his church and other ministries. He also became one of Andrew's *Foundation Builders* for the new Charis Bible College Colorado campus. "I figured since I wanted to go to school, I should sow a financial seed that would help other people go," he explains. He'd learned well the principle to sow where he wanted to go.

Through this process, Benjamin learned to trust God and rest in Him. He gave and received freely. Each semester, Benjamin would start classes not knowing where his funds would come from. "When I look back, I think to myself, *How in the world did I manage to do that every month?* It was an absolute miracle! Whenever I try to figure it out mathematically, it doesn't make sense. So, I just stop trying," he says with a shrug.

Benjamin not only earned his degree in film and video with a concentration in traditional animation, but he did it with straight A's and perfect attendance. And he did it debt free, all because of his decision to trust God, even when his situation looked impossible.

God is no respecter of persons. What He does for one, He'll do for all. If you are facing a financial drought, trusting God can lead to miraculous results, just as it did for Isaac and Benjamin. We encourage you to step out in faith and consider a partnering with Andrew Wommack Ministries. This ministry is good ground in which to sow your seed.

Event coordinators saw a man who had been paralyzed for six years get out of his wheelchair and take his first steps. One woman canceled her knee surgery and came to the conference in a brace. That brace now sits in an event coordinator's office as a memento of God's power and faithfulness. Another woman, undergoing chemotherapy, came to the conference wearing a wig. She testified during the event that her head started itching, so she took off her wig to find tufts of hair growing back! When asked about the amazing response they received from people, event coordinators said, "Faith works by love. When you show people in the Word how much God loves them, their faith comes alive. It's easy for them to receive from God."

Carlie Terradez, an event coordinator, said, "People left us with souvenirs of glasses, walkers, canes, crutches, and braces. We even got a handicap-parking permit! It was miraculous!"

Testimonies like these continue to flood in. Look at what people are saying:

"My body is *full* of the Holy Spirit—there's no room for sickness to stay!"



DON'T LIMIT

by Andrew Wommack

If you've ever been afraid in your walk with God, you've limited Him. That probably astounds you, but fear is the number one reason God can't do all He wants to do in your life. For instance, I limited God through a fear of change. I had reached a place in the ministry where things were working: People's lives were being changed, and I was enjoying relative success to what I'd experienced in previous years. There was light at the end of the tunnel, and it wasn't another train! So, I wanted to coast for a while, thinking, *Things are going well. Let's not push it.* I didn't want to go through the effort of rocking the boat. Most people probably wouldn't argue with that logic, but really it was just fear. And because of it, I began to let laziness set in.

Then, on January 31, 2002, the Lord spoke to me that I had limited Him through a fear of change. It was because of the way I saw myself. It wasn't that I'd been living in sin or hadn't been seeking God. It was the image I had of myself that wasn't right. I had small thinking. So, I called my staff together and told them, "I've got an image on the inside of me that has limited God. I don't know how long it's going to take to change this image—a week, a month, a year, or whatever—but I'm going to change. I will see myself doing what God told me to do." That was an important turning point in my life and ministry. This was how I took the limits off God!

I suspect that many of you reading this can relate to what I'm saying. It's typical for most Christians. It's not normal, but it is typical. And you may not have realized it, but you have an image on the inside that is a ceiling, or limit, on what God can do through you. It will take effort on your part if you're ever going to go beyond that ceiling.

The Scripture says,

For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he: Eat and drink, saith he to thee; but his heart is not with thee.

Proverbs 23:7

You have an image on the inside that is a ceiling, a limit, on what God can do through you.

You cannot see anything happen on the outside that you haven't seen happen on the inside. That's a big statement right there. You might be praying for your marriage to be restored, your body to be healed, or to prosper financially, but you need to meditate on the Word and let it paint a picture on the inside of you. Then whatever you're believing for will come to pass. It's a self-fulfilling prophecy. Your life today is the way you have seen it being. You might not like that, but it's true.

We take great comfort in passing the blame sometimes: "You don't understand. I don't have the education. It's my spouse. It's the color of my skin. I was abused as a child." We have a million and one reasons, but none of these external things are controlling our lives. It's the way we think in our hearts that determines the direction we're going. A lot of it amounts to being afraid of changing anything.

If you don't think people are resistant to change, just ask a pastor. They can tell you that getting people to change in our culture is nearly impossible. They'll say "This is just how I am" and will stick with that. The main reason they don't change is because they're lazy. I'm not saying that to be critical of anybody. I was the same

way. But there are many Christians who want to sit on their couches, watch television, and forget everything else. Then they wonder why they're not seeing more of God in their lives. They're comfortable. They've got their nest made, and they limit God because things are nice. That is not a good place to be. Let me ask you: Are you waiting on God, or is God waiting on you? That is a really good question.

It takes effort to change, but you'll never be a success as a Christian without it. I do have a book entitled *Effortless Change*, and you can change effortlessly—but it's not automatic. You will have to get into the Word and renew your mind (Rom. 12:2), and then as you think in your heart, so will you be (Prov. 23:7). So, in that sense, there *is* effort to change. It's just that it's not the way religion has taught it. It's not a legalistic, works-based change. Really, change is just a byproduct of your relationship with God.

It takes effort to change, but you'll never be a success as a Christian without it.

I guarantee you, God didn't make anybody to sit and coast. You can rest throughout all eternity. You don't need to *rust* out; you need to *wear* out. I've given up on ever getting to a place where I just coast. Right now, I'm believing God for bigger things than I've ever believed for before. I'll go to a church or meeting, and the minister will be preaching, "You need to believe





God!" Then Jamie will grab my leg and say, "You're believing big enough—just calm down." It's because I'll never quit dreaming! Until I go to be with the Lord, I've got a purpose that will keep me going.


I was with Oral Roberts just a couple of months before he died, and he was still preaching, meeting with people, and having people into his home. At ninety-something years

old, he was still taking the things God put in his life and depositing them into other people. That's strong! That's the way you need to go out.

You need to strive toward something bigger than yourself.

You need to stir yourself up, or you'll settle to the bottom. I know it takes a lot of effort to keep swimming upstream, hardly stopping to rest and constantly dealing with the possibility of failure. Sometimes it just seems better to take the easy way and hold off on changing things. But that's why you need to have a purpose. You need to strive toward something bigger than yourself, something that drives you.

I tell you, if you catch on fire for God, the world will come watch you burn. Everybody loves a fire. It captivates people. And people will be drawn to you once you step out in your purpose. Don't be afraid to try something different. Some people are shooting at nothing and hitting it every time. Do something, lest you do nothing. Get out of the boat, or you'll just drown with the rest of them. I pray that God is burning these things on the inside of you. He wants you to stop limiting Him.



All of our "achievements" won't seem like very much if we haven't done what God told us.

I had a fear of change because I was finally at a place where we were succeeding. Finances were coming in, and we weren't worried about survival. I could have stayed there and God would still have loved me, but someday, standing before Him, He would've told me He had called me for a lot more than what I did and that I had limited Him.

I'm encouraging you to stop limiting what God can do in your life. Give Him something to work with. He can only bless what you set your hand to (Deut. 28:8). You can learn more about how to do this in my new book, *Don't Limit God*. This has radically changed my life. I know it will change yours too.




CASON AND LAURA CRUZ

Cason Cruz was born again in high school, but he didn't have a personal relationship with God. Then one day, he attended an Acquire the Fire event with his youth group, and that's what literally happened to him—a flame ignited in his heart. Cason recalls, "It was in a time of worship when I got changed. It was my first encounter with the presence of God. He told me that He loved me and cared for me." It was there that God planted a seed in Cason's heart that he later realized was a call to the ministry, specifically music ministry. But he didn't want to be just a songwriter. He knew that God's call was more than that: It was a pastoral call. So, he considered going to seminary, but he did not feel a leading from God to do so. Eventually he enrolled in the New Life School of Worship and graduated and interned there. But Cason felt he needed a firmer foundation in the Word.

It was then that the Lord led Cason to Charis Bible College through his youth pastor, who encouraged him to fill out an application. Then God said, "Charis will be your home for the next two years." When Cason clearly saw this was God's plan for him, he accepted the call.

His first year at Charis turned out to be life changing. Andrew's teachings about grace fueled the fire in him. It gave him a greater revelation of the Word. Cason recalls, "It opened my eyes to see that there is a lot more than what we see in mainstream Christianity." Courses like *The Power of Grace* by Sean Michaud and Wendell Parr's *Holy Spirit* were building blocks on his foundation. Also, while in school, he served on the Charis praise and worship team, and that gave him the opportunity to develop great relationships and find spiritual mentors in Charlie and Jill LeBlanc. It was in the music room that he met his bride-to-be, Laura.

Laura graduated from Charis in 2010. She spent her second year leading worship in Charis Belfast, and

for her third year, she was helping Charis missionaries in India. Cason and Laura were married on September 8, 2012.

After graduating from Charis, God opened a door for Cason at Charis Christian Center, and now he serves there as worship pastor. 

Granted a True and Lasting

THE JULIE MAPATANO STORY

Julie Mapatano's journey to asylum in the United States and finding her purpose in Christ all began under the dictatorship of Mobuto Sese Seko in the Democratic Republic of the Congo. Even as a young girl, Julie's parents had to teach her and her siblings to trust God, to go to church, and to believe God for their daily lives. Julie, like many Congolese at that time, grew up under a dictator who could take the life of any citizen who dared oppose him.

In 1996, when civil war broke out in the Congo, Julie was eight months' pregnant and already raising three other young girls. She told her husband, Isaac, that this was their opportunity to leave. They fled to Kenya, and after several difficult years as refugees, they received the miracle they'd been praying for—they were offered asylum in the U.S.

Once relocated to Atlanta, Georgia, in 2000, Isaac and Julie got jobs in the hospital system. During those years of adaptation to American life, the Mapatano family grew larger still, welcoming another baby girl and their first son. They now had five girls and a son. It was during that time that Isaac discovered Andrew Wommack's teaching of the Gospel truth and God's unconditional love and acceptance of them. One day,

Isaac told his wife that she needed to listen to Andrew and that he's really good.

Julie explains that once they started listening together, they couldn't stop: "All of our lives, we were taught how we had to buy the love of God and that we had to do certain stuff in order for Him to love us." But Julie remembers when she first heard Andrew say, "You don't have to do anything. God loves you unconditionally." This was the beginning of them finding true, lasting asylum for their souls.

Eight years after their relocation to the U.S., change came rapidly to the Mapatano household. They attended Andrew's *Gospel Truth Seminar* in Atlanta, where they all received the baptism of the Holy Spirit. Julie

shares, "That was a really big deal for us because, before this, we believed that for someone to be baptized in the Holy Spirit, they had to be holy. It was a gift given only to certain people." From Andrew, they learned it was a gift given to every believer. "That really helped me a lot!" Julie exclaims.

Even though they were quickly learning about the nearly-too-good-to-be-true news of the Gospel, Isaac was just not satisfied. Everything so far had been an appetizer, but he was hungry for the full meal. Isaac drove from Atlanta to Colorado Springs for the Summer Family Bible Conference. During the conference, he knew in his heart where God wanted his family to be. When he got home, he shared this with Julie. Within a few short months, the Mapatano family moved to Colorado Springs, Colorado, and Julie and Isaac became first-year students at Charis Bible College.

Going to Charis was "a big deal for us," explains Julie. They had never been taught their identity in Christ, and they were just learning Christ's unconditional love for them. But a dream and purpose were birthed in their hearts during their first year of Bible college. They wanted to go back to the Congo to preach the Gospel and God's unconditional love: "Our dream was to tell our people about the Good News that we had found in Andrew's teaching."

As sudden and as sweet as that year of change had been for Julie and Isaac, Julie did not know that their lives were going to take another sharp and unexpected turn. About one week after they had completed their first year, Isaac suddenly became ill. He went home to be with the Lord three days later. This devastating blow changed Julie's whole life again. She was now a widow and left alone to raise their six children! Julie, however, was about to find out what a woman of faith she was and the strong resolve God had sown in her through Andrew and the other Charis instructors.

Julie remembers making a decision in her heart: "After Isaac passed away, I had to go back—back to the teaching and to the promises of God, to knowing who I am in Christ." She knew God wasn't the source of what had happened and that nothing bad had come from His loving hand. "Sometimes," Julie says, "I had to go back again and again and study all these promises of God. I had to walk by them every day." Finally, she came to a place where she knew that "there was nothing left for me to do but continue on and learn fully about this God who loves me unconditionally. It was then that I knew I had to finish what I started—not only for me but so that I was able to raise my kids in a godly way."

Julie began to see even more of God's faithfulness after she returned to Charis as a second-year student. As she continued to be renewed and healed from any sense of loss she had experienced, something wonderful was added to her heart. Julie remembers it was on a day that Andrew was teaching about visions and dreams. He posed this question to the class: "Do you know that

God's plan B for you could be better than His plan A?" The thought startled Julie. After class, she went up to greet Andrew. To her surprise, he looked at her and said, "God is not finished with you yet. God created everyone and put dreams and visions in everyone." Julie received this as a word directly from the Lord.

Two days later, Julie got a phone call from her dad, who was still in the Congo. He was the headmaster over a school for orphans, and he told her the heartbreaking news that he had to turn away orphans who hadn't paid their tuition. Something inside of Julie leaped in excitement. "I was so excited because I had just received my last tax return that was filed while my husband was alive, and I had been asking God what He wanted me to do with it." Julie sent the \$400 she'd received to the Congo. This seed in God's hand prevented the orphans from being sent back to their villages, and with this first step into active ministry, Julie was able to support 200 students in her father's school. Her heart felt full—"Wow! So, I still have a purpose for living!"

From that point on, God's plan B for Julie's life became her "plan-to-be." She realized that even though the dream of her and her husband going and preaching the Gospel around the Congo wasn't going to be fulfilled, God had a plan for her to go back and help the orphans of the Congo. Since her graduation from Charis in 2010, Julie has founded a ministry called Redeeming Love—D.R. Congo, and today Julie supports 100 Congolese children. Julie describes their mission: "We help kids—orphans—to be able to go to school. We help single moms and their kids eat. We pay for children to have uniforms, tuition, and medical treatments that they need. We send spiritual leaders to these families to give them hope and the love of God that they are missing on the inside." Julie says that her

biggest hope is to bring the unconditional love of God to many people and to let them know who they are in Christ. As Julie says, "You will wake up better and you will learn to love yourself more if you know you are loved by the Most High God—then you do not have to be defined by the things around you."



Julie's journey has taken her from receiving asylum in the U.S. to having her heart healed and filled by finding her purpose in God's "plan-to-be." "Knowing who I am in Christ and knowing His unconditional love changed my life completely—and all of it is due to Charis Bible College. Jesus became everything to me!"

OUT OF CONTROL!

Do a Google search for words like "depression" and "worry," and you might be surprised at what you find. A search for "depression" produces nearly 62 million results, "worry" yields 115 million, and "stress" gets you 155 million! It should go without saying, these are hot topics for people today.

And millions of dollars are spent on treatment costs every year for those people.

Stress in itself isn't a bad thing. It tells your body that it needs to respond in some way, like "fight or flight." But when the stressful situation passes, your body should go back to normal. This doesn't happen for most people dealing with stress. They get so used to living with stress that it becomes an everyday thing for them. You weren't meant to live that way!

Isaiah 26:3 says,

Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.

Does being stressed out sound like perfect peace? No! Living in a stressed state can cause all sorts of health problems: heart disease, high blood pressure, diabetes, depression, anxiety disorders, and on and on.³ That is not God's best for you! He created you for His pleasure (Rev. 4:11). He is not pleased by you being a stressed-out mess.

Stress, depression, and worry have become so prevalent in today's society that there's such a thing called the Anxiety and Depression Association of America. Prescription treatments are everywhere and are readily available for everyone, including teens and kids. And they don't think it matters that the side effects are worse than their original problem; they just want relief.

What most don't realize, though, is that relief is already theirs!

Jesus told us,

These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

John 16:33

Stress? Depression? Worry? I've got good news for you: Jesus has already dealt with all of these and has overcome them. He came to save *every part* of you—spirit, soul, and body. He paid the price so you don't have to. You are complete in Him (Col. 2:10). Thank You, Jesus!

So, where does all that stress and depression come from? It doesn't come from your circumstances. It comes from your reaction to your circumstances. Just because something negative happens to you doesn't mean you have to have a negative emotion correspond with it. Look at David in 1 Samuel 30. The Amalekites had attacked while David and his men were gone, destroyed the city of Ziklag, and taken their wives and children captive:

So David and his men came to the city, and, behold, it was burned with fire; and their wives, and their sons, and their daughters, were taken captives. [4] Then David and the people that were with him lifted up their voice and wept, until they had no more power to weep.

1 Samuel 30:3-4

This was a horrible situation. Many would've just given up, sat down, and mourned themselves sick. But David chose another way: He encouraged himself in the Lord (1 Sam. 30:6). And because of that, he was able to pursue the Amalekites and take back everything that had been stolen.

In Deuteronomy 30:19, God instructed us to choose life. He would be unjust to give you a command that you were unable to follow. If He says you can choose, you can choose! You have to get rid of the thinking that you are powerless when it comes to your emotions, that you have no authority over them. You do have a choice! You can choose to be bitter or better.

Let not your heart be troubled.

John 14:1a

This verse starts with the word "let," so the understood subject of that sentence is "you"—you let not your heart be troubled. It's up to you as to whether you allow your heart to be troubled or not. You control your emotions.

God created you with emotions. He meant for you to have them. When He finished creation, He said everything was good (Gen. 1:31). So, emotions are good! But just because they're good and you're meant to have them, that doesn't mean they should be controlling you. Emotions are not a response you have no control over and, therefore, have no responsibility for. You are not hostage to your emotions. You need to start telling them what to do instead of the other way around.

Someone may ask, "Well, what's the purpose for emotions?" God gave them to you to help you experience life the way He intended. You aren't meant to be emotionless or numb. As a born-again believer, one-third of you is wall-to-wall Holy Ghost! So, right now in your spirit, you have everything you need to bring your emotions into subjection, and that includes joy, peace, and self-control (Gal. 5:22-23).

Don't conform to the thinking of this world. You have been created to do awesome things for God (John 14:12), so don't let depression, worry, or stress hold you back from His plans and purposes for your life! Check out my teaching on *Harnessing Your Emotions* at www.awmi.net/extra/audio/1005.


