Tell us a little about yourself.

I'm a business coach, and my wife and I are from the Atlanta area. Six years ago we felt instructed to sell everything. We became homeless nomads, and through those travels we ended up where we are. The first place we felt that we were to go was to Woodland Park to visit some friends of ours. There, in a coffee shop one day, I met someone who invited us to Charis Christian Center in the Springs. We went, and after church they said, "You know, there's a Bible college next door." The next day we went, and Barry Bennett spoke. We looked at each other and said, "We're supposed to be in Bible

What is your favorite teaching of Andrew's, and how has it impacted you? I have a positive mental attitude. I trained my brain and studied. I also believe in physical fitness. I believe that partnership means a lot of things. I believe it actually means working together. I believe it means that you're kind of united. I believe that you're part of the organization. You are literally woven into it. Both parties are praying for each other. Both parties are pulling for each other. They want success for each other. In business, I've had good partnerships and bad partnerships. Words mean something to me. It's not a one-way relationship. I believe it's a weaving together, and that's significant.

I've been to a lot of business schools: the good, the bad, and the ugly. I believe the *Charis Business Summit* is one of the best business trainings that anyone can attend. It's rare in the world we're in that someone can take the supernatural and the natural and marry those two together. People have come from all over the world, and they're seeking roughly the same thing: What's God's purpose for my life? There's energy, and there are supernatural things going on. When I leave here, I'm going down to grab lunch that they've provided for us. I believe that the Lord has someone I'm going to connect with. The Lord wants to orchestrate divine connections for us. What is your occupation?

My occupation is program coordinator for the Colorado Department of Local Affairs' Main Street Program for the City of Woodland Park. Under that program, we do economic development for downtown Woodland Park. Working with the Colorado Department of Transportation is one of our roles as well. Our biggest partner is the City of Woodland Park and the Woodland Park Chamber of Commerce. That's how I ended up at the

Charis Business Summit. I've wanted to come, but we did not have it within our budget these last couple of years. I was at After Hours about a month ago for the Chamber, and I won a ticket to the business summit.

How did you become acquainted with Andrew Wommack Ministries and Charis Bible College?

Simply put, the teachings are black and white. There's no gray. And for me,... that type of simplicity in the message, and truly around the Word, is important.

We have an internship program for students in their Practical Government School. In fact, most of their third-year schools have internship opportunities. I had two interns come to the city to ask for internships, and one of them was a government student in third year. She did an internship with the City of Woodland Park through our Main Street Program, and she was very effective. That was my initial exposure to Charis Bible College. I love the teachings of Andrew Wommack Ministries. We're glad you're here. I see future partnership with the community and definitely with the city through Charis Bible College and AWM. There's a daily impact to our community from the college and the ministry being here.

How are you enjoying the conference? What do you like about it?

They're truly teaching business principles, with some religious basis. I took the Maximum CEO class under Dr. Radtke, and having a degree in economics, I felt that he really put forth economic principles and how to maximize your role as a CEO. Our organization is a 501c3, under a government umbrella. I just attended Karen Conrad's workshop on marketing plan development, and we are currently in the throes of developing a strategic plan. I will definitely be taking back the principles and guidelines that Karen laid out to help in the development of that strategic plan.

How are you being helped by the teaching at this conference?

Simply put, the teachings are black and white. There's no gray. And for me, with a very busy life, busy with children and family, that type of simplicity in the message, and truly around the Word, is important.


Butch Hartman - Hollywood, CA

How did you become acquainted with Andrew Wommack?


I met Andrew over twenty-five years ago when I was in Manitou Springs, and I have been able to follow his ministry on TV.
